Paikau St. Triangle Park has a new name – Operation Red Wings Medal of Honor Park – but most of us know it as Triangle Park. So if you see the Operation Red Wings sign, you're at the right place.

The park is dedicated to the Pearl Harbor Navy seals and others who died on a mission to Afghanistan in 2005 and to all Medal of Honor recipients. Nineteen men were killed in the



operation. Be sure to stop and read the memorial.

Also, remember your water. It's a long trek up that trail.
