1. IVV-Americas Special Program Book: You may have seen people with IVVAmericas Special program books. Any sanction stamp for an event in a country covered by the IVV-Americas, including the US and Canada, can be placed in this book. You don't need to walk for credit. The book requires 20 event stamps. Download the form from www.IVV-Americas.org. Click on "A Challenge" at the top and then on "Residents of USA" to download a form. Cost is \$12 for a patch and certificate or \$10 for a certificate only. Or if you see Curt Myron at an event, he is carrying forms with him and has books.
