On Tuesday, October 8th, 2019, Clark "Chuck" Soeldner, loving father, brother, grandfather, and friend passed away at the age of 75.

Chuck was born on February 16th, 1944, in Boston, MA, to A. Warren and Mary (Atkinson) Soeldner. He served in the US Air Force for twenty-four years, followed by a twenty-seven-year career with Global Credit Union overseas before retiring to Colorado Springs to spend time with family and friends. On any given day he could be found pacing off a new walk on the front range, run-walking three thousand meters up in the alps, or just keeping others company as they walked his favored Pikes Peak Greenway Trail. Always recognizable by his bright shirts, floppy hats, and mutton chops, he would strike up a conversation in any country and was known by many as a great friend. Chuck was also an avid train buff, never missing an opportunity to snap a photo of a locomotive for his collection, enjoy a scenic train ride, or add new rolling stock to his beloved N-scale Railroad.

Chuck was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his son Warren, his sister Carol, and several cousins, granddaughters and great-grandchildren.
