HALLOWEEN Klicks on Route 66

Since 2026 is an even-numbered year, it is time for the South Central Region to host their 13th biennial get-together known as their Regional Roundup. This year, the Dogwood Trailblazers, Sunflower Sod Stompers, Tulsa Walking Club, and Wandergruppe of OKC are combining their efforts to host "Halloween Klicks on Route 66". With the 100th anniversary of this famous highway's designation by Congress, it was a natural theme for our Roundup since the "Mother Road" went through 3 of our regions states.

Ten sanctioned walking events will be located in Kansas, Missouri, and Oklahoma near the Interstate 44 corridor. This extended weekend will start on Wednesday with the Dogwood Trailblazers' YRE walks of Joplin & Carthage. Thursday will be devoted to all 13.2 miles of US 66 in the Sunflower State. A traditional event will be sponsored by the Sod Stompers featuring the small community of Riverton. Just a few miles further down the Mother Road, the Baxter Springs YRE will be available. This event will start at the Heritage Center and Museum. Baxter Springs is known for its Fort Blair Civil War Historical Site and its well-preserved (& decorated) US 66 businesses.

Friday will be filled with 2 traditional walks in Oklahoma. The morning event will be in Miami & the afternoon walk will be in Will Rogers' hometown of Claremore. Both of these walks will have numerous signage, murals, and businesses associated with US 66. The Claremore event will start in the J.M. Davis Arms & Historical Museum. This Museum will also be place for our "Brats & Bites" on Friday evening before our travels to Tulsa.

On Saturday morning, the Tulsa Walking Club will be sponsoring a walk featuring the Gathering Place then the afternoon will be devoted to another traditional walk along 11th Street, known for its large, statue-like characters, signs and the old businesses that lined US 66.

Wandergruppe of OKC will sponsor traditional walk in Bristow on Sunday morning. This town features highlights of railroading days along with Route 66. The Chandler YRE will be offered as a "remote" registration for any interested participant for the afternoon. Each town will have some unique sites from this historic highway which helped with the westward settlement of the U.S. in the 1900's.

Two swims have been sanctioned for those who enjoy the water. Come and enjoy the indoor pool and earn more IVV events. Water walking is acceptable. There will be qualifiers for some of the AVA Special Programs. Each event has some different histories and things to see and to enjoy. Motel rooms are blocked; meals and restaurants have been arranged along with some area speakers.

There definitely will be fun, fitness, friendship and food on the agenda, so come enjoy this festive weekend as you do your "Halloween Klicks on Route 66" in the South Central Region!



TRAVEL INFORMATION

Events are located in the tri-state area of Kansas, Missouri, & Oklahoma - along the Interstate 44 corridor. Our first 3 days of activities will be centered around the Joplin area. Joplin is 155 miles south of Kansas City, and is 110 miles to the northeast of Tulsa, with OKC being 110 miles further away. The last 2 days will be in the Tulsa area.

Distance: 5km/10km

Location: Holiday Inn Express 3400 S. Rangeline Road

Location: The Holiday Inn Express will be the remote start/finish place for this event. HIE is 0.3mile north of I-44, Exit 8. Turn Left after the Kum & Go, & before the McDonald's. The hotel sits off Rangeline Road. Assisted registration will be in the lobby area. Once registered/checked-in, you will drive approximately 4 miles to a parking area & the start of the walk.

Start/Finish: Start 8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.; finish by 12:00 p.m.

Course: Walkers will see Rt. 66 murals in downtown Joplin. Memorial Hall opened in 1925 to honor our WW1 veterans. Our new Cornell Center presents musical entertainment along with several art galleries. Sections of the 1890's Murphysburg neighborhood are on the National Register of Historic Places. 10k walkers will walk Rt. 66 in the East Town neighborhood. Trail Rating 1-A

Distance: 5km-10km

Location: Boots Court Visitor's Center 125 S Garrison Ave.

Location: From Holiday Inn Express, go Right on Rangeline 0.3 mile to I-44. Turn Left & enter I-44, going east 3.1 mile to Exit 11B. Go north & east on Rt. 249 14 miles toward Carthage. In Carthage, go through 2 stop lights on Central Avenue, passing Sonic & Burger King. Turn Right at the third stoplight onto S Garrison. Boots Motel is 250 feet on the right. Route 66 Visitor Center just past the motel. Park at the Motel or the Pancake Hut just past the VC.

Start/Finish: Start 1:30 pm. – 2:30 p.m.; finish by 5:00 p.m.

Course: Walkers will follow Rt. 66 passing many of the older homes, Carthage Square, & Central Park. The grounds of the Congregation of the Mother of the Redeemer and Stations of the Cross are also on this trail. Trail Rating 1-A

Traditional Walk - Map Guided Distance: 5km/10km

Location: First Baptist Church 6895 Bluebird Lane

Location: The walk event will start/finish inside the First Baptist Church. From the Holiday Inn Express parking area, go Right on Rangeline 0.3 mile to I-44. Turn Right & enter I-44, going west 8.4 mile to Exit 1. Go Right on to US 400/US166 toward Baxter Springs. Follow US 400 for 8.0 miles where US 400 merges with US 169 Alt. North. Go Right on US 400/US 169 Alt. 1.8 mile to traffic circle. Go Right on Ks. 66 0.7mile to traffic signal. Left on SE 70th St. 0.2 mile to Bluebird Lane. Left on Bluebird Lane 500 feet. Park on the east side of the church.

Start/Finish: Start from 9:00a.m. - 10:30a.m.; finish by 12:30 p.m.

Course: Routes will be out and back. The course will be on the berm edging along Ks. 66 to Old Route 66 Park. The 10km route will continue on original Historic Route 66 to the Rainbow Bridge. Trails will lead through some residential areas of Riverton & open farmland. Surfaces will be cement & gravel roads. Trail Rating: 1-A

Location: Ks. Heritage Center & Museum 740 East Avenue

Location: From Riverton, go west on Old Route 66 traffic light to US 400 traffic circle. Left on US 400 3.7 miles to East 8th Street. Go Left 1 block to the Museum. From Joplin, same as to Riverton except follow US 166 (East 12th Street) west 2 miles, then turn Right on East Street 0.3 mile. Museum will be on the right side.

Start/Finish: Start 1:30 pm. – 2:30 p.m.; finish by 5:00 p.m.

Course: Walk is along residential streets and through Kiwanis Park. Historic downtown has been renovated with a theater and more buildings highlighting Rt. 66. Fort Blair and several Civil War historical markers are scattered along the walk. Trail Rating 1-B

Location: The walk event will start/finish in the foyer area of the Main Street Café Route 66. From Joplin Exit #8 (Rangeline Road), go west on I-44 for 22 miles to Exit #313 in Oklahoma. Turn Left on OK-10 N/E Steve Owens Blvd 1.4 miles to S Main St/U.S. Route 66. The Café is located at this intersection. Go straight through the intersection then turn Right after the Café. Please park in the area closer to "A" Street, leaving adjacent space for local patrons.

Start/Finish: Start from 8:00a.m. - 9:30a.m.; finish by 12:00 p.m.

Course: The routes will include the Main Street corridor featuring the downtown area with signage, murals, and businesses associated with US 66 along with some residential areas. Fairly flat surfaces will include streets & roads and sidewalks where available. Areas of full sun and wind exposure on the trails. Trail Rating: 1-A
